EVENTS ORGANISED

1. FAREWELL CUM WELCOME CEREMONY:

2. BOUGS Meeting

A meeting of Board of Undergraduate Studies (BOUGS) for the subject of Biotechnology was held on April 26th 2024. In the meeting, draft syllabus for Semester 5th and 6th in tune





with NEP-2020 was approved and all board members agreed that the Department shall coordinate with different Institutes like IIIM Srinagar, SKUAST-K and CITH, Old Airport Srinagar etc., for the conduct of 2-Credit Internship program in the specific domain.

3. SUBJECT TOURS/FIELD TRIPS

• <u>Gulmarg Tour</u>: The trip was organized by the Department of Biotechnology in collaboration with Department of Clinical Biochemistry on 23rd April, 2024 for the students of 6th Semester. The main aim of the trip to Gulmarg was to give students





comprehension about the mismanagement of waste water on the fragile ecosystem. The students were accompanied by the faculty of both Departments.

• SKIMS Tour:

On 11th June, 2024, Department organized Educational Trip for the 4th semester students to the Department of Advanced Centre for Human Genetics and State Cancer Research Institute at Sher-i-Kashmir Institute of Medical Sciences (SKIMS) Soura. Twenty five students accompanied by Dr. Roohi Mushtaq, Prof. Mohammad Iqbal



Sofi and Ms. Zarina Bano visited labs of the Institute pertaining to different aspects of Genetics and Cancer Research.

This trip was organized with an aim to bridge the gap between theoretical knowledge and practical application.



The objectives of the visit were:

- > To observe the advanced facilities and equipment used in human genetics.
- > To gain insights into the role of genetics in medical sciences.
- To gain insights into the nature and types of cancer.
- > To learn about chemotherapy and the key drugs used in cancer treatment.
- ➤ To observe the clinical care provided to cancer patients, especially children.
- To understand the supportive care facilities available for patients.





• **Doodpathri Tour:** On October 15th, Department organized Education tour to

Doodpathri for students of 5th Semester. The objective of the trip was to provide students with hands-on experience of Plant Biotechnology in a natural setting, expose them to the natural habitat of





various plant species, create awareness regarding role of Biotechnology in conservation & sustainable development, and collection of some important Medicinal Plants of Kashmir in Hilly

areas (Doodpathri). The students were accompanied by the faculty of the Department.

4. HANDS ON TRAINING ON 'HPLC'

The Department of Biotechnology in collaboration with Department of Chemistry organized a Hands-on Training on High Performance Liquid Chromatography (HPLC) for

the students of 4th semester on April 23, 2024. The training aimed to provide with participants practical knowledge and skills in operating **HPLC** instruments, understanding its applications and analyzing data.

The training included a lecture followed practical session. Dr. Mushtaq Ahmad (Assistant Professor,



Chemistry) of GDC Pulwama acted as the resource person during the event. During the entire session, the queries of the participants were satisfactorily answered by Dr. Mushtaq.

5. EXTENSION LECTURE

The Department of Biotechnology, in collaboration with the Department of Zoology, organized an Extension Lecture titled "Breast Cancer: Awareness and Prevention" on November 30, 2024. The lecture was delivered by **Dr. Manzoor Ahmad Mir**, Head of

the Department of Bioresources, University of Kashmir. It was attended approximately 200 enthusiastic students who showed great interest in the topic.

warmly welcomed by Prof. Robina Kousar (Head, Department of Zoology), and Prof. Sameena Ismail (Assistant Professor, Biotechnology). The In-charge Principal, Prof.

Shagufta Nasreen, greeted the guest with a bouquet of flowers. The program began with an introductory speech by Dr. Roohi Mushtaq, followed by a welcome address delivered by Prof. Tariq Ahmad Chalkoo, Coordinator of Skill Development and Staff Secretary.

Dr. Mir delivered a comprehensive and engaging lecture focusing on early detection, prevention strategies, and the importance of widespread awareness of breast cancer. The session concluded with a lively Question-Answer session, a segment, where students and faculty actively participated, showcasing their deep interest in the subject. Dr. Bilal Maqbool Beigh, Assistant Professor, Department of Computer Applications, provided technical support for the event.

6. 15- DAYS RESIDENTIAL INTERNSHIP PROGRAMME

5th semester students as part of their curriculum. The main objective of the internship programme was to provide students with broad and deep understanding of Biotechnology and
